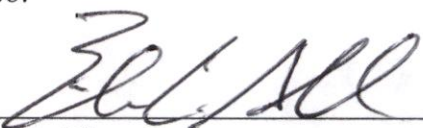
JUDGMENT OF CONVICTION

The State of Indiana appears by Prosecuting Attorney, Jarrod Holtsclaw, and the Defendant, Dale L. McNeal, Jr., appears in person, in custody of the Greene County Jail, and with attorney of record, Ellen Martin.

The Court now grants the defense motion to enter a plea of guilty to the charge of Child Solicitation, a Level 5 Felony. The Court now finds that the Defendant is 47 years of age, that he understands the nature of the charges against him to which he has pled guilty, that he understands the possible sentences and fine thereunder, that his plea was freely and voluntarily made, that the plea is accurate and that there is a factual basis for Defendant's plea of guilty. The Court accepts the plea of guilty and accepts the plea agreement and finds the Defendant guilty of Child Solicitation, a Level 5 Felony.

It is now ordered and adjudged by the Court that the Defendant, Dale L. McNeal, Jr., who is a male person, 47 years of age, is guilty of the crime of Child Solicitation, a Level 5 Felony.
